### **OUR FOUNDATION**

---

At Judah Bible College, every detail of our academic structure is designed with intention. The course numbering system is more than an administrative tool — it is a clear, organized framework that helps students, faculty, and staff understand the scope, depth, and progression of our training.

This document outlines the official numbering system, the meaning behind every prefix and digit, and the complete master list of every course offered across all three of our degree programs. It exists so that anyone — a prospective student, a returning student, a faculty member, or a transferring institution — can look at any JBC course number and immediately understand what it represents.

We have built this system to be clear, scalable, and reflective of our convictions. Every course at Judah Bible College serves the same purpose: to raise up Spirit-filled, biblically grounded believers who will rise, mobilize, and take their rightful place in advancing the Kingdom of God.

## THE NUMBERING FORMAT

---

Every course at Judah Bible College follows a simple, consistent format: a three-letter department code followed by a three-digit course number.

### **BIB 101**

#### *Old Testament Survey*

**BIB** = Department | **1** = Year/Level | **01** = Sequence within department

## DEPARTMENT CODES

---

Every course belongs to one of six academic departments. The three-letter prefix identifies which department a course falls under and signals the kind of formation that course provides.

<b>SPF</b>	<b>Spiritual Formation</b>	Christian living, character, holiness, Holy Spirit, spiritual warfare
<b>MIN</b>	<b>Ministry</b>	Practical ministry, healing, deliverance, evangelism, pastoral care, preaching
<b>LDR</b>	<b>Leadership</b>	Leadership development, team building, administration, ministry ethics
<b>PRA</b>	<b>Practicum</b>	Hands-on, supervised ministry practicum experiences

## LEVEL NUMBERS

---

The first digit of every course number identifies the level of the course. Lower numbers represent foundational training; higher numbers represent advanced and capstone work. This progression mirrors the spiritual journey we want every student to walk — from foundation, to formation, to fruitfulness.

<b>NUMBER</b>	<b>LEVEL</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
<b>100</b>	<b>Year 1 — Associate</b>	Foundational courses; introduction to Scripture, theology, and spiritual formation
<b>200</b>	<b>Year 2 — Associate</b>	Building on the foundation; deeper book studies, advanced theology, ethics, ministry intro
<b>300</b>	<b>Year 3 — Bachelor</b>	Advanced biblical studies and ministry foundations
<b>400</b>	<b>Year 4 — Bachelor</b>	Capstone studies, advanced ministry, leadership, and practicums

## SEQUENCE NUMBERS

---

The final two digits of every course number distinguish individual courses within a department and level. Within each department, sequence numbers also follow a consistent logic that signals whether a course is required or elective.

- **01–09** — Required courses for that department and level.
- **10–99** — Elective courses, additional offerings, or specialized topics within that department and level.

*For example: BIB 201 is a required, second-year associate-level Biblical Studies course (Biblical Theology), while BIB 210 is an elective, second-year associate-level Biblical Studies course (The Parables of Jesus).*

## LOOKING AHEAD

---

This numbering system is designed to scale with the school as God expands the vision. As new courses are added, new tracks are introduced, or new departments emerge, the framework will accommodate that growth without disruption.

### **Recommended practices for adding new courses:**

- Always assign new courses within the existing six departments when possible. New departments should only be added when an entirely new field of study emerges that cannot fit within the current structure.
- Required courses receive sequence numbers 01–09 within their level. Electives and specialized offerings receive sequence numbers 10–99.
- If a department exhausts its 01–09 slots at any level, redistribute by moving the least-foundational course to the elective range rather than breaking the convention.
- When a course is permanently retired, do not reuse its number for a different course. Retired numbers remain on the historical record for transcript clarity.
