VISION

To raise up a generation of Spirit-filled, biblically grounded believers who will rise, mobilize, and take their rightful place in advancing the Kingdom of God.

CORE VALUES

1. The Word (Biblical Authority): *2 Timothy 3:16–17 (NLT)* — "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip His people to do every good work." We believe the Bible is the final authority for doctrine, leadership, and life. Culture does not shape our convictions. Scripture does. Every class, every conversation, and every decision flows from the Word of God.

2. The Spirit (Spirit-Empowered Living): *Acts 1:8 (NLT)* — "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be My witnesses, telling people about Me everywhere..." We believe the Holy Spirit is not optional — He is essential. We pursue His presence, His power, and His voice in every aspect of training. We teach believers to hear Him, move with Him, and depend on Him so that ministry flows from the overflow of intimacy, not the strength of effort.

3. Character (Spiritual Formation): *Colossians 1:28 (NLT)* — "So we tell others about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship to Christ." We are not merely transferring

information. We are forming Christlike leaders. Our goal is spiritual maturity, not just ministry activity. Character matters more than charisma. Integrity matters more than influence.

4. Authority (Kingdom Demonstration): *1 Corinthians 4:20 (NLT)* — *"For the Kingdom of God is not just a lot of talk; it is living by God's power."* We believe the gospel is not only proclaimed — it is demonstrated. We train believers to walk in the authority Jesus gave them: praying for the sick, casting out darkness, hearing God's voice, and bringing heaven to earth. We do not settle for theory. We pursue the manifestation of the Kingdom.

5. Leaders (Leadership Development): *2 Timothy 2:2 (NLT)* — *"You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others."* We intentionally identify, develop, and deploy leaders. We are committed to equipping men and women who can carry responsibility, build teams, and steward influence with integrity. Leadership is not a position — it is a stewardship.

6. The Church (Local Church Commitment): *Ephesians 4:11–12 (NLT)* — *"Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do His work and build up the church, the body of Christ."* We believe the local church is God's primary strategy for advancing His Kingdom. This school exists to strengthen the Church, not compete with it. Every student is expected to be planted, serving, and submitted to a local body.

7. Multiplication (Kingdom Expansion): *Matthew 28:19 (NLT)* — *"Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations..."* We are not building consumers. We are raising reproducers. Every leader we train should be equipped to disciple others and advance the Kingdom of God beyond themselves. We measure success not by who comes — but by who is sent.
